TERMS & CONDITIONS

The undersigned (the 'Participant') hereby submits its application to participate as a retail vendor in the Bash on Wabash (the "Bash on Wabash") to be held on August 6th & 7th, 2005. **By submitting this application, the Participant expressly agrees to the terms and conditions below:**

- Bash on Wabash is a neighborhood festival produced on behalf of the Greater South Loop Association (GSLA) for the purpose of promoting the community of the GSLA. Bash on Wabash is a primary fundraising activity for the GSLA. **StarEvents, LLC and the GSLA shall have the right to control all aspects of Bash on Wabash.** The Participant agrees to conduct its business in a manner most likely to enhance the success of Bash on Wabash and the reputation of StarEvents, LLC and the GSLA. In the event that StarEvents, LLC shall determine, in the exercise of its sole discretion, the Participant is acting in a manner detrimental to Bash on Wabash, StarEvents, LLC or the GSLA may expel the Participant from Bash on Wabash, and the Participant shall forfeit its entry fee.

- **Bash on Wabash will take place on August 6th & 7th, 2005** on Wabash Street from 13th Avenue to 14th Place. If the Participant's Vendor Application is accepted by StarEvents, LLC, the Participant agrees to remain open for business between the hours of 12:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on both Saturday, August 6th and Sunday, August 7th, 2005.

- The Participant desires to participate in Bash on Wabash by providing retail or hand crafted and other merchandise for sale to the general public. If the Participant's Application is accepted by StarEvents, LLC, **the Participant agrees to offer only those items listed on the application**, no other goods will be permitted without prior writ-

ten consent of StarEvents, LLC. The Participant can not sell or distribute merchandise that includes, "Bash on Wabash" or "GSLA", without prior written consent of StarEvents, LLC.

- The Participant acknowledges that its application may be accepted or rejected by StarEvents, LLC in the exercise of its sole discretion and that, if its application is accepted, its participation will be subject to the terms and conditions contained herein. **Only those applications submitted on or before July 1st, 2005**, and accompanied by the **payment in full** of the applicable entry fees, and the completed **City of Chicago Itinerant Merchant License Application** shall be considered. StarEvents, LLC shall notify the Participant whether its application has been accepted or rejected, on or before July 15, 2005. In the event that the Participant's application is rejected, the entry fee will be refunded. StarEvents, LLC does not guarantee exclusivity to any Participant, nor has the Participant relied upon any representation or guarantee of StarEvents, LLC regarding the revenues to be generated by the Participant.

- If the Participant's application is accepted, the Participant will be assigned a space within Bash on Wabash area with the approximate **square footage of 10 feet by 10 feet**. Additional space may be made available by StarEvents, LLC, upon receipt of the Participant's application, at an additional cost to be determined by StarEvents, LLC. The location of the Participants space within Bash on Wabash area shall be determined by StarEvents, LLC in the exercise of its sole discretion, and the Participant agrees to accept the space as assigned by StarEvents, LLC. The Participant agrees to conduct its business only within the space assigned by StarEvents, LLC.

- **The Participant will be solely responsible for the appearance of its space.** The Participant shall be ready to operate its business by 11:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday August 6th and 7th. The participant will forfeit the assigned space if unoccupied by 10:30 a.m. on Saturday or Sunday. The Participant shall remove all vehicles and other items used in conjunction with setting up for event prior to 11:00 a.m. **No amplified sound will be allowed in booth - for more details, please contact StarEvents at (773)665-4682.** The Participant shall maintain its space in a neat, clean and sanitary condition during Bash on Wabash and shall dispose of all trash produced as directed by StarEvents, LLC. The participant is responsible for returning all tables, chairs and tents rented at event to StarEvents, LLC.

- The Participant shall comply with all local, federal, state and municipal laws and ordinances in the operation of its booth during Bash on Wabash and shall insure its merchandise against loss by theft or damage. **The Participant hereby releases StarEvents, LLC and the GSLA, its officers, directors and members from any and all claims for, and agrees that StarEvents, LLC and the GSLA, its officers, directors and members shall have no responsibility for, personal injury sustained by the Participant, its agents or employees, or damage to, or loss or destruction of, the Participant's property.** The Participant further agrees to indemnify and hold StarEvents, LLC and the GSLA, its officers, directors and members harmless, from and against any and all claims for personal injury, damage to property or theft occurring in or about Bash on Wabash area, whether to the Participant, its agents or employees or any third party, caused in part or in whole by the participation of the Participant in Bash on Wabash.
